

RRHA is going Smoke-Free...



The Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) has implemented a **Smoke-Free Public Housing Rule**.

RRHA MUST comply with the rule and implement its smoke-free policy **no later than July 30, 2018**.

This rule will apply to all apartments and buildings owned and operated by RRHA. There will be no permitted smoking of lit tobacco products (such as cigarettes, cigars, pipes, and water pipes), e-cigarettes or hookahs within **25 feet** of a public housing unit (building, doors or windows) or administrative building.

To implement HUD's Smoke Free Rule all residents of the Richmond Redevelopment and Housing Authority communities MUST sign a lease addendum...
