- Safety First | Restore safety to public housing and senior communities
- Resident led initiative (Mandatory feedback from residents on how to patrol the community)
 - Trained, licensed and armed security officers
 - On-the ground patrols walking the community
 - Interactive Community Engagement

(before any security officers step foot on our properties)





WHO IS SENTRY FORCE?

- Experienced in conflict resolution and de-escalation tactics
- Officers well-trained and armed
- Familiarity with public housing communities (Norfolk Redevelopment & Housing Authority)
- Tactical and strategic approach to patrolling communities with resident input

- All tips will be investigated and determined to be credible or non-credible (Depending on nature of tip or concerns expressed, investigations may take up to 60 days)
