# **Chair Updates**

Chair Jackson welcomed everyone and stated he was pleased with how all the opinions that have been expressed online, etc. have been handled and how everyone has been informed concerning the Gilpin concerns. Chair Jackson is making an official statement recommending the discussion of Gilpin Section 18 application and Gilpin Redevelopment be sent to the full board at the next meeting.

# Conduit Bond Application – Joyfield at German School Road Multifamily Housing Project

A presentation was given by Standard Communities (Caitlin Gossens and Judd Ullom) describing what the project would look like as far as affordable housing, rent, amenities, etc. It was expressed that having MBE/WBE and minority contractors included would be preferred and having that language added to the resolution before the full board meeting next week.

Several residents spoke about questions they had concerning how many affordable housing units there would be and whether the residents would have an opportunity to receive equity in the project.

# **Real Estate Department Updates**

Ms. Greta Harris spoke to the board concerning the development of Northside and the challenges with cost of labor and materials, etc. since COVID and that market rate developer have moved away from the project and an amendment will be added to the resolution before it is brought before the full board to make it clearer and streamlined.

- ~ **Gilpin Court** A lot about been learned since April concerning the Gilpin Court Redevelopment plan through meetings and CEO Nesmith has suggested that the creation of a resident advisory committee to the RDC would be a great idea to empower residents.
- ~ Nine Mile/Sprout School Project This is a very exciting project and a great opportunity.
- ~ Creighton Court Redevelopment Event will be September 16<sup>th</sup> from 10:00 to 12:00 and will be very exciting to hand out keys and it has been a long time coming.
- ~ Mosby Court Redevelopment TRG is the developer, and the CUP application has been submitted and is awaiting approval.

~ **Grace Place** – Things are moving towards finalizing and signing an MDA. Meetings are ongoing with the residents.
